

- 1 8. WHEREAS, sustainability is a broad term that can be linked to several academic
2 disciplines from politics, education, and developmental psychology, to other
3 topical areas as well; and,
4
5 9. WHERAS, the President’s Climate Commitment curriculum requirement could be
6 achieved by revising CORE to be more reflective of our current global
7 sustainability concerns by creating new interdisciplinary courses that would
8 integrate or focus on sustainability;” and,
9
10 10. WHEREAS, requiring every University of Maryland student to complete a CORE
11 course incorporating sustainability into the greater goal of a well rounded liberal
12 arts education would be a critical step in encouraging students to successfully
13 meet future sustainability challenges;

15 11. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Student Government Association
16 (SGA), on behalf of the University of Maryland student body, finds sustainability
17 to be a subject worthy of formalized education and necessary to achieving the
18 University’s Climate Commitment; and,

20 12. BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that the SGA would like to see the CORE Planning
21 and Implementation Team ensure that the principles of sustainability and global
22 citizenship are represented in the CORE curriculum for University of Maryland
23 students in the near future.
